## Directions to Camp Sawtooth:

**From Boise:** I-84 to Mountain Home. Take Exit 95/Hwy20 towards Fairfield/Sun Valley – 83 miles. Turn left at Hwy 75 going to Ketchum – 26 miles.

**From Pocatello:** I-86 at Pocatello, drive west – 70 miles. Merge onto I-84 continuing west – 37 miles. Take Exit 174/Hwy 93; go north to Shoshone – 20 miles. Continue North through Shoshone to Hwy 75 towards Bellevue/Hailey/Ketchum – 56 miles.

**From Ketchum to Camp:** At the last stop light in Ketchum, Saddle Road, continue 8 miles north. Turn right at the Sawtooth National Recreation Area Headquarters (SNRA). Continue 1.5 miles (the road changes to gravel), turning left onto bridge into camp.

## Which Camp to Attend:

Campers should attend the camp of the grade they will be going into the upcoming fall. Graduating seniors are welcome to attend 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade camp.

## Activities:

Campers enjoy fun activities while living and learning in a Christian environment, enjoying a program specifically designed for them by our Program Staff. Activities include outdoor games, crafts, hiking and swimming, picnics, and road trips.

**3rd & 4th grade camp** – go swimming, go on short hikes & play games each day along with worship, chapel and evening campfire.

**5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade camps** – take a road trip to either Alturas or Red Fish Lake for a picnic, swimming and a day of fun & games will be a highlight of this camp, so bring your swim suit and water toys.

**7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade camps** – make a trip into Ketchum for a fun day of ice skating, making new friends and trying to stand up on the ice. Small groups, worship, fun games and lots of surprises fill this camp.

**9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grade camp** – take a trip to Baldy Mountain. Campers will have a choice whether they would like to hike or take the ski lift to the top of the first ski resort in America.

**11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade camp** -- enjoy a full day of rafting.
