Camp Host Position Description & Duties

The Camp Host provides the necessary care and maintenance of the camp facilities, equipment and assists in the needs of the Summer Staff.

- Camp Sawtooth is a Christian Camp. Conduct and attitude of the Camp Host will reflect the camp's mission. As Jesus Christ is our teacher and role model, the Camp Hosts are teachers & role models to the Campers and representatives of Camp Sawtooth.
- The Camp Host volunteers for weekly increments during the resident camp schedule.
- Daily: raise and lower flag each morning & evening and as inclement weather requires.
- Daily: build a fire in Hawley Lodge fireplace each morning prior to the 7:30am Staff meeting.
- Restock firewood/ kindling/paper & cardboard in Hawley Lodge as needed.
- Cut down kitchen boxes and put in dumpster.
- Build fire for each evening camp fire.
- Take trash out of kitchen each evening.
- Sweep off landing & steps in front of lodge and on side and back patio.
- Restock the northern most campfire ring with fire wood, kindling & paper as needed.
- Clean out ashes from all fireplaces and fire pits.
- Makes repairs as needed, and as skill allows, as requested by the Directors.
- The Camp Host may participate in off campus camp activities such as rafting, swimming, etc.
- Other duties may be added or re-assigned as deemed necessary by the Camp Directors and/or the Camp Board
