HEALTH CARE – A Volunteer Position

Health Care Volunteer Responsibilities

Health Care applicants must complete a Camp Sawtooth Volunteer Application Form.
A background check will be completed for all adult volunteers.

Listed below is a brief outline of some of the things you will experience at Camp as a Health Care Volunteer.

- Health care is supervised by the Health Care volunteer, who is certified in at least CPR and American Red Cross Standard first Aid or equivalent. Preference is given to a medical health provider (i.e. RN, EMT, LPN, CNA, physician, etc.).
- One position is available at each camp for a Health Care volunteer.
- **Required:** Training and information for Health Care volunteer 3:00pm on the first day of Camp.
- Be available for Check-in of Campers at 4:00pm.
- During check-in of campers: Review medical forms with each camper as they arrive.
- During check-in of campers: Receive all medications and record on a log sheet for each camper with dosage/times, and store in locked medical cabinet. At the end of the week all log sheets will be given to the Camp Directors to keep on file.
- Distribute medications to campers each day as indicated on their log sheet. The job of distributing medications will not be handled by anyone other than the Health Care Volunteer unless the Camp Directors are notified in special circumstances.
- Report any medical problems or uncooperative behavior immediately to Camp Directors.
- Supervise the health screening and care of the campers and staff.
- Administer First Aid to any injuries or illnesses along with transporting to Medical Facilities if needed. The rule of “three” applies and will be accompanied by the Camp Director or Program Staff member.
- Maintain health records & incident reports. The Health Care Volunteer will complete incident reports for all illnesses, injuries, and medical, be it physical or mental, issues. This includes when a camper reports injury, abuse or unsafe situations at home; as required by law. All incident reports will be given to the Camp Directors to be kept on file.
- Inventory medical supplies and provide list to Camp Directors.
- Prepare first aid kits for hiking and trails programs.
- Health Care volunteer along with the Camp Directors will provide the Program Staff and Cabin Parents with any health issues of the campers in their cabin. The kitchen staff is informed of any food allergies.

Health Care volunteers are provided:

- Room and meals; A 50% campership for one of their own children, per camp they assist.

This is an excellent opportunity for Health Care volunteers to use their gifts and to be spiritually renewed. The camp experience offers the opportunity to grow in your Christian faith while helping others. It will be a week of fun, friendship, growth and memories.
