Cabin Parent Responsibilities

Listed below is a brief outline of some of the things you will experience at Camp as a Cabin Parent volunteer.

Cabin Parent applicants must complete a Camp Sawtooth Volunteer Cabin Parent Application Form.
A background check will be done for all adult volunteers

- Seven positions are available at each camp; 3 male and 4 female.
- Training and information meeting: 5:00pm on Sunday, the first day of camp. (Right after Camper check-in)
- You will be paired with a Program Staff member and under their direction, assist and care for a cabin group of 9 to 12 campers for the week.
- The Program Staff is involved with the planning and executing of all activities. This may require more of their time than being in the cabins or with the campers at all times. The Program Staff and the Cabin Parent must communicate as to who is with their group of campers. If the Program Staff is not available, the Cabin Parent is in charge of their group. Report any concerns you have regarding the welfare of your campers to the Program Staff and to the Directors.
- Lead, teach, share life experiences and participate in all program activities and meals.
- Stay with campers in the cabins during rest hours. Activities, crafts and free time are planned by the Program Staff but if you have a small project or fun activity you would like to share with the campers, please bring your ideas and supplies with you for this time period.
- Know the location of their campers at all times.
- Must be High School graduates and at least 18 years of age.
- Responsible for the care and Christian nurture of their assigned campers; and the community well-being of the cabin group.

Cabin Parents are provided:

- Room and meals.
- A 50% campership for one of their own children, per camp they assist. Camperships are nontransferable.

This is an excellent opportunity for volunteers to use their gifts and to be spiritually renewed. The camp experience will enable the Cabin Parent to grow in their Christian faith while helping others to do the same. It will be a week of fun, friendship, growth and memories.
