CABIN PARENT – A Volunteer Position

Cabin Parent Responsibilities – Listed below are brief outline of some of the things you will experience at Camp as a Cabin Parent volunteer.

- + Seven positions are available at each camp; 3 male and 4 female.
- + Training and information meeting: 3:30 p.m. on Sunday, the first day of camp.
- + You will be paired with a Program Staff member and under their direction assist and care for a cabin group of 9 to 12 campers for the week.
- + Lead, teach, share life experiences and participate in all program activities and meals.
- + Stay with campers in the cabins during rest hours.
- + Know the location of their campers at all times.
- + Must be High School graduates or at least 18 years of age exceptions for 3rd-4th Grade Camp and 5th-6th Grade Camps may be granted with the approval of Camp Directors.
- + Responsible for the care and Christian nurture of their assigned campers; and the community well-being of the cabin group.

- This is an excellent opportunity for volunteers to use their gifts and to be spiritually renewed. The camp experience will enable the Cabin Parent to grow in their Christian faith while helping others to do the same. It will be a week of fun, friendship, growth and memories.
- Room and meals are provided for the week.
- Cabin Parents may receive a 50% paid campership for one of their own children, per camp they assist. Camperships are nontransferable.
